Evaluation

Depth	Pottinger 2530 for 2.5m and SICMA EC300 for 3.0. Deeper penetration option if needed.
Rotors	Maschio and SICMA have the most. More rotors and denser means that the soil is broken up more.
Cat	Kuhn allows for 2 or 3. Pottinger is only 3.
HP and Weight	SICMA has the largest range of HP, meaning it can fit more tractors. Also it's the heaviest, with the thickest steel.
