## Evaluation

<b>Working Width/ Total Width</b>	For the side shift flail mower, SICMAs have the same working width for a skinner machine. Its better engineered.
<b>Weight</b>	Kuhn is the heaviest, for the side shift, SICMA is the lightest with the same mulching capacity.
<b>Mulching</b>	Maschio has higher mulching capacity.
<b>HP</b>	SICMA has the <u>largest range of HP</u> . One SICMA tiller will fit more tractors than the other brands; its more versatile.
<b>Reach</b>	Maschio and Kuhn have higher reach.
<b>Hammers</b>	SICMA has higher number of hammers for the side shift and second for the mulcher.

Question	Answer
What makes SICMA mulcher durable?	SICMA builds its own GEARBOXs. In house quality control and are overbuilt on purpose with little vibration.
What makes SICMA mulchers different?	Tight hammer spacing. High blade density.
